## 参考答案、提示及评分细则

1. A 细节理解题。根据 **Stellar Soccer** 部分“Address: 1047 Amsterdam Ave”可知,Stellar Soccer 位于 Amsterdam Ave。
2. C 细节理解题。根据 **Downtown United Soccer Club** 部分“Training is offered to players of all ages and genders(性别).”可知,16岁的小孩可以加入 Downtown United Soccer Club。
3. B 细节理解题。根据 **Coney Island Cyclones Soccer Club** 部分“Their programs include a soccer academy(学院), as well as winter and summer camps that have indoor and outdoor facilities.”可知,Coney Island Cyclones Soccer Club 会组织冬令营和夏令营。
4. D 细节理解题。根据第二段“The *Very Hungry Caterpillar* was Mr. Carle’s best-known book. It was published in 1969.”可知答案。
5. B 细节理解题。根据第三段“As he was growing up, Mr. Carle spent a lot of time with his father, who would take him out walking in nature.”及第四段“Mr. Carle thinks this helps explain why so many of his books are about nature.”可知,Mr. Carle 的父亲经常带他亲近大自然,所以他认为这可能是他的书大部分是关于自然主题的原因。
6. D 细节理解题。根据第五段“Author Bill Martin, Jr. asked Mr. Carle to illustrate his book *Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?*, which is Mr. Carle’s first try.”可知答案。
7. A 写作意图题。纵观全文可知,作者介绍了一位童书作家的成长及创作经历,结合他去世的消息可推断,作者写本文的目的是为了纪念这位多产的作家。
8. A 细节理解题。根据第二段“Like millions who are taking on work-from-home positions, the project manager of an Internet company sees it as a way to escape her small apartment and remain productive.”可知,Zheng Zheng 每天游走于不同的咖啡店铺是一种在居家办公的间歇放松并保持工作高效的方法。
9. B 细节理解题。根据第五段“Zheng said, ‘Remote working gives me great flexibility...’”可知,远程办公的灵活性是 Zheng Zheng 比较看重的优势。
10. C 词义猜测题。根据画线词所在句的语境及下文的“In a University of Chicago study, employees were found to work longer hours at home for the same task, as focused time was broken up by some distractions like childcare and online meetings.”可推断,画线词意为“延长了的”。
11. D 观点态度题。根据最后一段“Robin Dunbar, a professor of the University of Oxford, told CGTN that he believes remote working is overhyped(过度夸大) and certainly won’t last long.”可推断,Robin Dunbar 教授认为远程办公被人为夸大了,不会持续太久,故他对于这般办公的未来持怀疑态度。
12. B 细节理解题。根据第三段“Jessica Martin, who teaches art at West Side School in Healdsburg, California, thought her students just might have the magic words to bring calm to people in these difficult times. So Ms. Martin, along with artist Asherah Weiss, worked with students on a project they called ‘PepToc’.”可知,Jessica Martin 认为孩子们的童真童语可以给困境中的人带来安宁,故与艺术家 Asherah Weiss 一同启动了 PepToc 这个项目。
13. A 细节理解题。根据第五段“Pressing 1 brings up ideas for people who are ‘feeling mad, frustrated or nervous’.”可知,那些感到愤怒、受挫和紧张的人们应该按 1 号键。
14. C 推理判断题。根据最后一段“Ms. Martin thought the project would only attract interest from people near the school. But the hotline was soon getting hundreds of calls a day. Words of the hotline spread quickly on social media. The hotline has become incredibly popular with stressed adults, patients in hospitals, older people in homes...”可推断,Jessica Martin 不曾料到这个热线会如此受欢迎。
15. D 标题判断题。文章首段即本文的中心段,点明了文章的主旨,故答案选 D。
16. C 根据本段的小标题 **Be positive** 以及空后“If you’re someone who likes to discuss hopeless-sounding situations, that’s OK, but remember to talk about more cheerful topics, too.”可知,C 项“关注积极的一面会让你成为一个更好的朋友”符合。
17. A 根据空后“Listening helps you learn about your friends and support them when they need it.”可知,A 项“倾听他们”符合。
18. E 根据空后“don’t immediately share your experiences or advice.”可知,E 项“如果你的朋友分享了让他们纠结的事情”符合。
19. G 根据空前“Spending time with your friends has a huge impact, whether it’s for a few minutes or for several hours.”可知,G 项“和朋友一起安排有趣的活动,或者找时间聊聊天”符合。

20. B 根据空前“‘I know you’re trying to be funny, but when you call me that, I get really embarrassed.’”可知,B项“请不要那样叫我”符合。
